Linda and Helen are sisters who are descended from the Cavert and Mead founding families. They came to the area to see where their grandparents grew up, to find the home on Sweetman Road of their grandfather, Walter Lane Cavert, to find the Mead home on Sacandaga Road, where their grandparents were married, and some of the graves. With our help they definitely found the Mead house. We gave them a copy of the map of the old section of Sweetman Cemetery, given to us by Judy Curtiss, and they located many of the Cavert graves. Gail was able to share a story about how he knew Rev. Walter Dudley Cavert, the youngest child of their grandparents. They also were given a great tour of Union college, where their grandfather Cavert and uncle Cavert were educated. For our records, Linda gave us a copy of memoirs of growing up in Charlton, written by Walter Lane Cavert for his grandchildren.
